
God Is My Rock

Goal: To trust God's presence in times of trouble.




Here is a picture of King David remembering when he was a boy.

Expresses sadness about something that is wrong

Asks God for help or forgiveness

Psalms helps people talk with and worship God.

God Is My Fortress



This is a fortress.

A fortress is a place that provides a city all they need and keeps them safe from enemies.

In our Bible Story today, David says, "God is my fortress, I will not be shaken."

God Is Always With Us

Turn off all distractions and sit in silence for a moment. Listen for sounds that are around you, the breathing of your family members, the sounds of nature or neighborhood.

Know that you are not alone.

God may be found in one another, in your community, and within yourself!

Now look for some rocks. Choose a rock and remember a time that God was with you in a time of trouble. Place the rock inside a clear container. Use the rocks as a reminder of God's presence with you always.
