

COVID Safety Protocol

Adult Education Classes

- 1) Participants are asked to self-screen for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 before arriving at church.
 - a) Do you have any symptoms associated with COVID-19?
 - i) Fever (>100.4)
 - ii) Chills
 - iii) Cough
 - iv) Shortness of breath
 - v) Sore throat
 - vi) Diffuse body aches (not limited to a localized body area)
 - vii) New loss of taste or smell
 - b) Have you tested POSITIVE for COVID-19 or have you been in DIRECT contact with anyone who has a confirmed POSITIVE test for COVID-19?
 - c) Are you awaiting COVID-19 test results?

If you are able to answer a YES to any of the above symptoms or test results, we ask that you do not attend the Adult Ed Class.
- 2) Adult Ed Classes will meet in designated classrooms.
- 3) All participants will wear masks at all times while inside the building, unless medical conditions prohibit. Individuals should bring their own masks.
- 4) Participants will practice social distancing. Room set ups will be configured accordingly.
- 5) Each class will be supplied with an attendance sheet and are asked to complete each time they meet. Leave sheet in the classroom.
- 6) Beverages will be allowed, but masks must be worn except when taking a drink.
- 7) Classes using PCOC facilities will spray down or wipe down/disinfect all areas used after each meeting. Areas include, but not limited to: tables (tops and undersides), chairs, counters, door handles, light switches, cabinets, etc. Cleaning supplies will be located in each classroom.
- 8) All health and safety concerns, including any individual contracting COVID-19 should be reported immediately to Rock (rock@pcoc.us) for contact tracing purposes.
